At the end of the third and final day of competition of the Republic Bank Caribbean Junior Open Golf Championships 2010, Talin Rajendranath has emerged victorious in the Boys 16 – 17 division with a collective score of 221. Jake Delaney has placed second with a score of 231, and Jessel Mohammed, just four points shy, placed third with 235.

Brittany Marquez is the overall winner (girls) and the champion of the Girls 16 – 17 category, with a magnificent 241. Natalyia Rahamatula (251) and Aleema Jack (257) placed second and third respectively.

In the Girls 14 – 15 division, Alyssa Rahamatula (268) kept her game in control on the second and third days to grasp the overall lead in her age group. Christina Ferreira shot a steady 273 and claimed second place, followed by Arianne MacKenzie in third place (277).

Jamaican, Johnathan Newnham, is the champion of the Boys 14 – 15 division, as he shot 224. Matthew Marquez remained in second place with a cumulative score of 232. Robert Boocock placed third with 245.

In the Boys 13 & Under, Sachin Kumar playing only for the second time in this 54-hole tournament showed tremendous talent, shooting in the 70's for the first two days, and with an overall score of 238, was crowned the winner in his age group. Followed by Wan Ju Lee with 249 and Axl Bailey with 254.
